The Hawai'i Department of Education wants to provide College and Career Readiness support for all students as they plan for their futures after high school. Therefore, all grade 11 students will be administered the ACT Plus Writing Test at their schools on **Tuesday, March 3, 2015** free of charge. This College and Career Readiness ACT Plus Writing Test is comparable to the test that you may pay for your child to take on a Saturday at a National ACT Test Center in Hawai'i. ACT will mail your child's test results to your home three to eight weeks after the testing has been completed.

The ACT Plus Writing is a curriculum-based test that provides helpful information for all students based on their academic strengths in English, Mathematics, Reading, Science, and Writing. The test also provides information about your child's areas of strength and need for each subject and his or her interest in going to college and getting a job after high school based on an Interest Inventory that your child will complete along with the test.
