

**MUWaiākea High School**  
**Title I Status Notification**  
**Thursday, August 16, 2012**

Waiākea High School is a Title I school for the 2012-2013 school year

- Fourth year as a Title I school (2009-2010 was the first year)
- What is a Title I school?
  - High enough percentage of students applied for and were approved to receive free/reduced lunch
  - School receives Federal funds to supplement programs and services

As a part of it's Title I status, Waiākea High School will provide Supplemental Educational Services (SES)\*

- SES takes the form of free tutoring
- Tutors are provided by independent third parties
- Applications to receive tutoring will be available in September at the office or from the Title I Coordinator
- \* SES is undergoing restructuring. Services may be different than previous years. Information will be forthcoming.

Waiākea High School is Title I as a “whole school” and no longer as “Targeted Assist”

- What is a “Whole School”?
  - Federal funds can be used to assist any and all students, services, programs at the school
  - Need to have at least 40% of student body apply and qualify to receive free/reduced lunch
  - Funding has been used for:
    - On-line instructional programs
    - Tutors
    - Laptops for student use
    - Resource Room
    - Additional academic/attendance monitoring and guidance
    - Parent/Teacher resources
    - Substitutes/Stipends for teachers when they attend training
    - Consultants for math and instructional strategies
- What is a Targeted Assist school?
  - Federal funds can only be used to assist a portion of the students

When and How can I apply for Free and Reduced Lunch Services?

- Applications are available at the school office
- Applications are accepted year round
- Deadline to submit applications for Title I status is September 14, 2012

How can my child receive Title I Services?

- Free tutoring is available in Q104 to all students, regardless of Free/Reduced Lunch status.
- Additional academic/attendance monitoring and guidance is provided through referrals by the Counseling Department.
- Student laptop access is available in Q104 to all students, regardless of Free/Reduced Lunch status.
