SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP

GROMET FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP - The Gromet Foundation provides scholarship grants to college bound high school seniors. To be eligible, and applicant must : Submit application form which has been countersigned by a counselor at the high school at which the applicant attends; SAT scores, tax returns, transcripts, letter of recommendation.

This is a scholarship for financially disadvantaged students who excel academically. Award : \$1,500 annually for students attending Hawaii universities and \$5,000 annually for students attending mainland universities.
