COP provides a free, intensive 6 - wk summer academic and residential program, which is designed to prepare individuals for a successful freshman year at the UHM. Applicant must be a Hawaii resident and U.S. citizen, national or person holding a permanent visa; cum. GPA of at least 2.0; has not earned more than 12 college credits above the 100 level.
