UHMANOA COLLEGE OPPORTUNITIES PROGRAM

UHManoa College Opportunities Program (COP) is pleased to announce the call for applications for their 2011 Summer Program. The COP program provides an alternative pathway for individuals who desire to attend the UHM but who lack the minimum requirements for admission. COP provides a free, intensive 6 - wk summer academic and residential program, which is designed to prepare individuals for a successful freshman year at the UHM. Applicant must be a Hawaii resident and U.S. citizen, national or person holding a permanent visa; cum. GPA of at least 2.0; has not earned more than 12 college credits above the 100 level.

If you are the first in your family to attend college, and can represent themselves as a positive role model, you may qualify for the COP program. Program runs from July 5, 2011 to August 12, 2011.
