UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII REGENTS AND PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Seniors !! The University of Hawaii would like to announce that the application process for the 2011 UHawaii Regents and Presidential Scholarships are now open. The scholarships cover full tuition to any UH campus for up to 4 yrs, \$4,000 per year stipend, and one-time\$2000 travel grant. To qualify, applicants must have SAT combined score of at least 1950 on all three sections or ACT composite score of at least 29; GPA - 3.5 in academic subjects; extracurricular achievements.
