# Waiakea High School PARKING RULES/APPLICATION

#### **PARKING ON CAMPUS**

Parking on the school campus is a privilege, which requires a parking permit. Any vehicle parked on the Waiakea High School campus without a current parking permit will be subject to tow away at the driver's expense. Students may park in the approved student parking lot area only with proper authorization (current parking permits). Student parking permits will be issued on a first come first serve basis.

#### **RULES**

- 1. The parking permit is to be displayed and visible on the registered vehicle listed on this application at all times.
- 2. Students may only park in the Upper student parking lot within the designated marked stalls (#57 #202). ALO Students at the Portables 30-32 (Gym Parking lot stalls #426-428)
- 3. Speed limit is 10 miles per hour on the school campus. NO exhibitions of speed will be tolerated.
- 4. The parking lot is off limits to all students during the school day. Vehicles are not to be used as a school locker.
- 5. Report all thefts or vandalism immediately to the administration so that we may assist you in making a police report.

Please adhere to all the rules and regulations pertaining to on campus parking or you will lose your parking privilege for the rest of the year. Students are encouraged to commute to school via the school bus.

- 1. Pick up a Student Parking Application from the main office.
- 2. Fill out the application completely and obtain all the required signatures.
- 3. Bring payment & completed application along with the following current original documents when turning in application.
  - A. Current driver's license
  - B. Current safety inspection
  - C. Vehicle no fault insurance card
  - D. Vehicle registration
